


A. The value of R_{θJA} is measured with the device in a still air environment with T_A=25° C.

B. The power dissipation P_D is based on T_{J(MAX)}=150° C, using junction-to-case thermal resistance, and is more useful in setting the upper dissipation limit for cases where additional heatsinking is used.

C. Repetitive rating, pulse width limited by junction temperature T_{J(MAX)}=150° C, Ratings are based on low frequency and duty cycles to keep initial T_J=25° C.

D. The R_{θJA} is the sum of the thermal impedance from junction to case R_{θJC} and case to ambient.




Figure 1: On-Region Characteristics

E. The static characteristics in Figures 1 to 6 are obtained using <300μs pulses, duty cycle 0.5% max.

F. These curves are based on the junction-to-case thermal impedance which is measured with the device mounted to a large heatsink, assuming a maximum junction temperature of T_{J(MAX)}=150° C. The SOA curve provides a single pulse rating.

G. L=60mH, I_{AS}=7.8A, R_G=25Ω, Starting T_J=25° C.

H. C_{o(er)} is a fixed capacitance that gives the same stored energy as C_{oss} while V_{DS} is rising from 0 to 80% V_{(BR)DSS}.

I. C_{o(tr)} is a fixed capacitance that gives the same charging time as C_{oss} while V_{DS} is rising from 0 to 80% V_{(BR)DSS}.




Figure 2: Transfer Characteristics




Figure 3: On-Resistance vs. Drain Current and Gate Voltage




Figure 4: On-Resistance vs. Junction Temperature




Figure 5: Break Down vs. Junction Temperature




Figure 6: Body-Diode Characteristics

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


Figure 7: Gate-Charge Characteristics




Figure 8: Capacitance Characteristics




Figure 9: Coss stored Energy




Figure 10: Current De-rating (Note F)




Figure 11: Maximum Forward Biased Safe Operating Area (Note F)








Figure 12: Normalized Maximum Transient Thermal Impedance (Note F)



Gate Charge Test Circuit & Waveform
